Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) Vaccine Booster Shot Mass Vaccination Site Newly Opening

First and foremost, I would like to express my sincerest gratitude to everyone for your continued cooperation in preventing the spread of the novel coronavirus (COVID-19).

As you may already know, infections of the new Omicron strain are spreading rapidly across the nation, and has continued to spread even in Ehime Prefecture.

For this reason, to accelerate booster vaccine rollouts, <u>we have decided to</u> <u>open a mass vaccination site at the Ehime Prefectural Cultural Center every</u> <u>Saturday and Sunday from February 26 (Sat) to March 20 (Sun). The vaccine</u> <u>used will be Moderna.</u>

It is intended for those who live in Ehime and have already received their booster vaccination voucher. Appointments can be made at the website or call center listed below. Please make an appointment as soon as possible to prevent the continued spread of COVID-19 and limit the severity of the situation.

*On the last day, Sunday 20 March, vaccinations are available only in the afternoon (2:30-5:30pm).

- Must have an Ehime residence card or other proof of residency
